

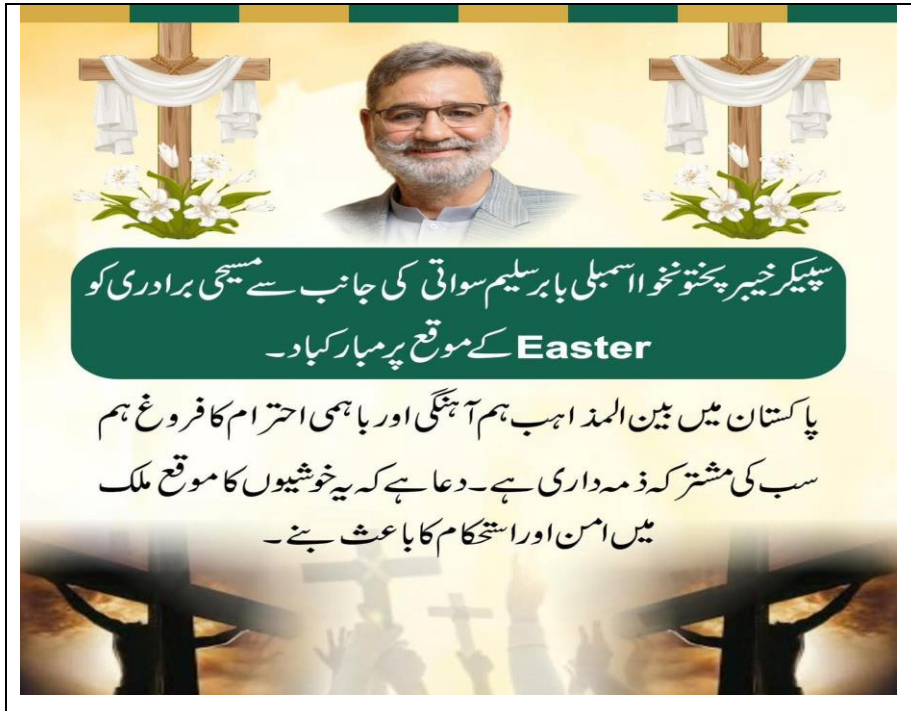
ACTIVITIES OF THE PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA
