

Recent Activities of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Provincial Assembly

Speaker Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Assembly Holds High-Level Meeting with Provincial Ombudspersons

Speaker of the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Hon'ble Babar Saleem Swati, met with the Provincial Ombudspersons of Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa to discuss institutional collaboration, governance reforms, and inter-provincial cooperation. The meeting reviewed the Assembly's ongoing legislative and digital governance reforms, preparations for the upcoming Commonwealth Women Parliamentarians (CWP) Conference, and the existing MoU with the KP Ombudsperson Secretariat.
